Standard 1:

The leaders of our school, have a responsibility to make sure that all children are safe at school. They need to educate all the staff, volunteers and community members about Child Safety.





Standard 2:

Standard 3:


All staff and volunteers need to follow rules and behaviours to keep children safe. This is called a Code of Conduct.





Standard 4

All staff, volunteers and people who come to do jobs in the school, need to have a Working With Children Check or need to be investigated (Police Check) to make sure they haven't hurt children in the past.





All staff and community members need to know how to report an incident if they suspect a child is being hurt in some way or is feeling unsafe.





Standard 6

Emmaus Catholic Primary School needs to constantly identify, reduce, remove or make some changes to things that might make children feel unsafe.





In Jigsaw and catch-up sessions, all children are taught to have a voice, to say how they are feeling, especially if they are feeling unsafe. They are taught how to speak up if they are worried or feeling unsafe. They are taught to tell a trusted adult.
