

Religious Education

In Religious Education this term, we are learning about the concept of freewill and how our conscience guides Christians to make good choices. We will also be exploring the Christian practices, signs and symbols of fasting, almsgiving and prayer in Lent. In the unit, Holy Week, we will explore the choices that Jesus and His friends made during Holy Week and how they influenced others.

Specialist Subjects

Visual Arts

In Visual Arts this term, we will be learning about Expressionism through the artworks of Edvard Munch.



Italian

In Italian this term, we will be focusing on practising to articulate what year level we are in. We will also be following Italian instructional language used in the classroom.



Physical Education

In Physical Education this term, we will be displaying our ability to change from an attacking to a defending player within game situations, such as netball, soccer and basketball. After playing sport, we will reflect on our body's physiological responses to the exercises performed.

In Reading, we will be learning about the structure and language features of a narrative text. We will investigate how authors hook the reader using different techniques.

Writing

In Writing, we are learning to be creative in our narrative texts by following the Seven Steps for Writing Success. We are learning how to plan for success using sizzling starts, tension tightening techniques and dynamic dialogue.

Speaking and Listening

For Speaking and Listening, we will be learning how to adjust our speaking in different situations to suit our intended audience.

Library / Author Study

In Library, we will be looking at books written by Glenda Millard. We are learning lots of new words to extend our vocabulary.

Social and Emotional Learning

This term we are focusing on how we can be bucket fillers and we are leaning to make new friendships as we get to know our new classmates.



Mathematics

During the term will be posing questions, collecting data and creating a variety of displays. We will become skilled data interpreters.

In the unit on place value, we will be also reading, writing and ordering numbers up to six-digits. We will be learning about decimal numbers to the thousandths.



Inquiry

Our topic question for Inquiry this term is 'What does it mean to be a good cyber citizen?' We will be learning that digital technologies can be used to communicate with others. We will also be learning about the importance of being a good digital citizen by making good choices online. We will be learning how to use our new MacBooks as an effective learning tool.
