



### Religious Education

Our unit this term is 'Celebrating Together.' We will focus on exploring the Part of the Mass:

### Specialist Subjects

#### Italian

In Italian this term, we will be learning vocabulary related to the seasons. We will be making comparisons between Australia's and Italy's seasons.

#### Physical Education

In Physical Education, we will be practising and refining movement skills and game tactics for net games, such as volleyball, badminton and tennis.

#### Visual Arts

In Visual Arts, we will use the topic of "The Sea" to explore collage, construction and drawing techniques in artworks.

### Literacy

#### Reading

This term we will be learning about parts of speech (nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs) through reading of different procedural texts.



We will explore the structure, purpose and vocabulary of procedures such as recipes, instructions and Science experiments.

#### Writing

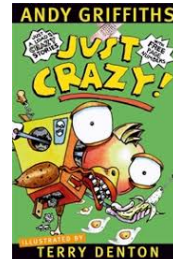

#### Speaking and Listening

Throughout Term Two, we will continue to focus on language variations, such as how and why language is varied to suit different purposes and audiences.

### Mathematics

#### Number Facts

Keep practising those times tables! Last term we focused on 2s, 5s and 10s - so make sure to revise those regularly. This term we will focus on 3s, 4s and 11s.

#### Addition

We will be using mental and written strategies to solve addition problems.



#### Location

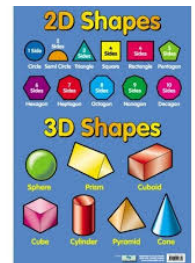
This term we will be using atlases and learning about maps, directional language and location.

#### Subtraction

We will be using mental and written strategies to solve subtraction and difference problems. We will also look at the relationship between addition and subtraction.

#### 2D Shape

We will be using mathematical language to describe and compare 2-dimensional shapes.



#### 3D Objects

We will be using mathematical language to describe and compare 3-dimensional objects, such as prisms and pyramids.

### Social and Emotional Learning

This term our focus will be on conflict resolution. We will be learning the different strategies we can use to help solve our problems when we are with our friends.
