


 <p><u>Religious Education</u> During Term 3, we will be exploring the Bible by looking at the different parts (Old and New Testament) We will be exploring certain parts of the Bible in more depth, including Creation narratives, Psalms and Parables.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p><u>Reading</u> Narrative structure, vocabulary and literary features, including fairytales, parodies and Dreamtime stories.</p> <p><u>Writing</u> Planning, composing, revising and editing different types of narratives, including fairytales, parodies and Dreamtime-style stories.</p> <p><u>Speaking and Listening</u> Varying reading style when reading to different audiences.</p> <p><u>Library / Author Study</u> Reading and reviewing Children’s Book Council of Australia (CBCA) nominated book-of-year books.</p>	<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p><u>Number & Algebra</u> <i>Multiplication</i> - using mental strategies to calculate multiplication problems, times tables. <i>Division</i> - using mental strategies to calculate division problems, relating division facts to times tables.</p>  <p><u>Measurement & Geometry</u> <i>Time</i> - Reading analogue and digital clocks to the nearest minute, calculating simple elapsed time. <i>Area</i> - relating area to multiplication, and using multiplication to calculate area of simple shapes.</p> 
<p><u>Specialist Subjects</u></p> <p><u>Italian</u> In Italian this term, we will be making comparisons between the Australian and Italian weather.</p> <p><u>Physical Education</u> In Physical Education, we will be performing gymnastic actions such as rolling, weight transfer and balances.</p> <p><u>Performing Arts-Music</u> In Music this semester, the students will be learning about the elements of music such as beat, rhythm, tempo and dynamics. They will be exposed to the instrumental families and their importance within an orchestra.</p>	 <p><u>Inquiry</u></p> <p>What is the history of Australia and its people? We will be learning about the first people of Australia and their culture and relationship to land. We will be investigating the rich aboriginal culture through stories, dance , music and artwork. We will be exploring the impact of european settlement on the aboriginal culture.
