

Religious Education

In Religion, we will be preparing for our Sacrament of Confirmation. We will be learning about the Gifts of The Holy Spirit and what role they play in Confirmation. We also will examine the Holy Spirit and how we can be filled with the Holy Spirit during and after Confirmation.

Specialist Subjects

Italian

For Speaking and Listening, we will be discussing different aspects of immigration and how we are impacted by the cultural diversity in Australia.

This term in Library, we will borrow each week and continue to take home our take home readers. We will be examining the book Wonder by R. J. Palacio and completing various tasks that will be linked to the themes of the book such as identity, inner and outer beauty and self confidence.

We will also enjoy reading and responding to various Book Week books.

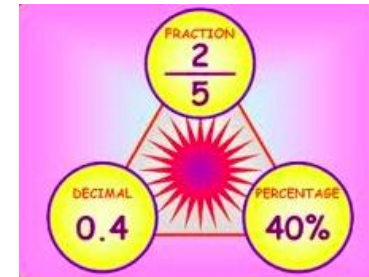


Mathematics
