

Emmaus Catholic Primary School Topic Overview for Families

Term 1, 2020 Year 6

Mathematics

During the term we will be focusing on data and place value. The children will also be completing mental math tasks.

We will be focusing on creating two-way column graphs and interpreting data from a range of sources.

During the data unit, we will also learn how to recognise misleading data in the media.



Inquiry

In Inquiry, students will be investigating digital citizenship. We will be learning how to stay safe online and the risks that are involved with using digital devices.

<u>ICT</u>

This term we will be learning how to be responsible digital citizens. We will be focusing on how to make safe, responsible and informed choices when online. We will be investigating our digital footprint and how this can impact us now and in the future. Students will be working towards obtaining an eSmart Digital Licence.

Religious Education

In Religious Education, we will be exploring ways in which we communicate with God, through prayer and in other ways. The learners will explore how we can connect to God through the Holy Spirit. We also will be focusing on Lent and how this time is a

special time to refresh our relationship with God.

Specialist Subjects

Visual Arts

In Visual Arts this term, we will be learning about the Australian artist Nicole Kelly and how she uses painting techniques to create landscape artworks.



<u>Italian</u>

In Italian this term, we will write facts about the Roman Empire. We will create and produce a project or powerpoint related to the Roman Period.



<u>Physical Education</u> In Physical Education this term, we will be demonstrating refined fielding skills when playing games such as cricket, T-ball and rounders.

Literacy In Reading, we will be exploring Graeme Base, author and illustrator of picture books. We will be exploring a variety of his texts, comparing his style of writing and illustrating. Throughout our cyber safety unit, we will be analysing factual information through a range of multimodal texts.

In Writing, the students will be investigating a variety of persuasive texts. We will focus on persuasive techniques, such as emotive language and modal verbs when writing expositions, speeches, etc. We will also be developing note taking skills and summarising information from a range of sources.

In Speaking and Listening, students will be exploring public speaking and in particular, speeches as a way of persuading the audience.
