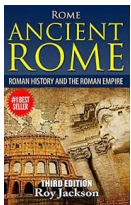


In Religious Education this term we are learning how, where and why we communicate with God. We will also be learning about Lent, which is a 40 day journey from Ash Wednesday until Holy Week. We will focus on showing acts of peace and reverence during the liturgical season of Lent.

In Visual Arts this term, we will be learning about the Australian artist Lauren Berkowitz and how she uses recycled materials to create 3D sculptures.



In Italian this term, we will be reading, listening and viewing historical information about the Roman way of life.



In Physical Education, we will be describing the benefits of exercise to physical and social health and mental wellbeing.

In Reading, we will be learning about the structure and language features of a narrative text. We will investigate how authors hook the reader using a variety of techniques.

In Writing, we are learning to be creative in our narrative texts by following the Seven Steps for Writing Success. We are learning how to plan for success using sizzling starts, tension tightening techniques and dynamic dialogue.

For Speaking and Listening, we will be learning how to adjust our speaking in different situations to suit our intended audience.

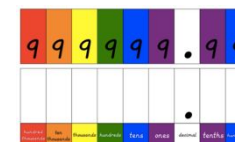
In Library, we will be looking at books written by Glenda Millard. We are learning lots of new words to extend our vocabulary.

During the term, we will be posing questions, collecting data and creating a variety of displays. We will become skilled data interpreters.

In the unit on Place Value, we will be reading, writing and ordering numbers up to six-digits. We will be learning about decimal numbers to the thousandths.



Our topic question for Inquiry this term is ‘How can I make the internet a safer place?’ We will be learning that digital technologies can be used to communicate with others. We will also be learning about the importance of being a good digital citizen by making good choices online.
