Specialist Subjects

<u>Italian</u>

In Italian this term, we will be reading, viewing and recording facts about Italy's identity, the culture and landmarks.

Physical Education

In Physical Education this term, we will be collecting, recording and organising information to investigate which physical activities people engage in to maintain health, wellbeing and fitness.

In Visual Arts this term, we will be studying Collage and drawing inspiration from picture storybook authors/illustrators such as Lois Elhert . We will be exploring collage techniques using a variety of materials.

RESILIENCE

This term's focus will be Resilience. Everyone faces adversities, from minor disappointments and disagreements, to more significant losses and hardships. Resilience is an important skill that will help children learn to manage feelings of stress, worry or anxiety. They will learn about strategies to help them face, overcome and even be strengthened by the challenges in their lives. Building upon our learning from Term 1, we will continue to develop our research skills using non-fiction texts related to our Inquiry unit. We will focus on the skills of skimming and scanning, as well as revise the use of glossaries and indexes. We will also practise map-reading skills as we learn about the world.

Literacy

<u>Writing</u>

This term we will explore persuasive exposition texts, by exploring and presenting one side of an argument. We will continue to focus on handwriting, revising and editing.

Speaking and Listening

Throughout Term Two, we will continue to focus on language variations, such as how and why language is varied to suit different purposes and audiences.
