SCHOOL FEES

ICT UPDATE

Google Meet Class Conference Calls

Throughout this last week, teachers have been meeting with individual students using Google Meet. The calls have been working well and the staff have loved seeing the students, hearing their voices and sharing what they have been up to.

Next week, teachers will be hosting whole class check-ins via Google Meet. This will be a time for students to learn how to use Google Meet as a group. It will be an opportunity for the students to see each other as well as their classroom teachers. They will learn how to take turns and listen to one another during a video conference call.

There will be two sessions per day on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Children can choose to connect to one or both of these calls.

Times for these calls are:

Prep Classes: 10am and 2pm

Year 1 and 2 Classes: 10:30am and 2:30pm Year 3 and 4 Classes: 9:30am and 1:30pm Year 5 and 6 Classes: 9am and 1pm

The Teachers will email the students the codes (nicknames) for the sessions.

A parent/carer will also need to be present during these calls.

Hapara is currently having some outage issues which means some users may experience drop outs. We have contacted Hapara and the issues are across other schools too. Their engineers are working on these issues. Hopefully things will run smoother in the coming days. We thank you for your continued patience on this matter.

A reminder that students are not permitted to email other students. Student emails are monitored by staff. We will contact you if we notice any unusual activity.

- 4. All scheduled College Tours have been cancelled. Once we are able to host visitors at the College, tours will recommence. We are aware that post 'isolation', families may be reluctant to take time off work and/or have their children take time away from the classroom, and as such, the College will offer a number of tour options.
 - Option 1 Our regular school tour: This tour runs on a school day, commencing at 9.15am, and finishing at approximately 11am. The tour includes an introduction by the College Principal, a presentation, a tour of the College grounds and facilities, and an opportunity to chat with Leadership and Enrolment staff and student ambassadors over morning tea.

Option 2 - An 'after hours' tour: This tour will provide a shortened version of our regular morning tour. Families will receive a presentation by the College Development Officer, Mr Manny Gambin, followed by a tour of the school grounds and facilities. This tour will occur outside of school hours so as to minimise disruption to work and/or school commitments. Please be aware that with this tour you will not have the opportunity to meet Leadership staff or student ambassadors. If you do have questions following the tour, you will be more than welcome to contact the relevant staff at a later date.
