Term 3, 2020 Year 1

Religious Education

In Religious Education this term we will explore the big question of "How can we respond to God's call to be stewards of the earth?"

We will be discovering the wonders and beauty all around our world through acts of kindness, behaviours and the environment . We will make connections to Scripture and take action as God's stewards.

Specialist Subjects

Italian

In Italian this term, we will be reciting the vocabulary and sentences about days, months and seasons.

Physical Education

In Physical Education this term, we will be focusing on staying active, enhancing our fitness and challenging our body by performing fun activities requiring a variety of movement skills, such as running, dodging and skipping.

Visual Arts

In Visual Arts this term, we will be focusing on the skill of Drawing. We will be experimenting with a variety of drawing techniques and incorporating the elements of art such as line, shape and colour into our artwork. All art activities will be planned around the use of easy to access art materials.



Reading

We will be reading and sequencing many fairytales and imaginative texts to prepare us for narrative writing. We will be identifying the characters, setting, problem and solution in a narrative.

Literacy

Writing

The focus this term will be on writing narratives. We will explore the correct sequence of a narrative and use adjectives in our writing to make it more interesting. The children will begin to edit their own work looking for things like punctuation and capital letters.

Spelling and Grammar

We will be continuing with the Jolly Phonics program and investigating different aspects of grammar such as nouns, verbs and adjectives.

Speaking and Listening

We will be describing characters, settings and events in narrative texts. We will also be focusing on speaking clearly and listening to others during Google Meets.

Library / Author Study


This term, we will be listening to a variety of storybooks by Author Study, Margaret Wild.

Mathematics

In Mathematics, we will be learning about addition. We will continue to build an understanding that when we add two or more collections together, it creates a bigger number.

We will also be learning about subtraction. We will investigate how to create a smaller number when we take one collection away from another.

We will be learning to solve addition and subtraction problems using a range of strategies.



Social and Emotional Learning
