

Religious Education

In Religious Education this term we will explore the big question of “ **How can we respond to God’s call to be stewards of the earth?**”

We will be discovering the wonders and beauty all around our world through acts of kindness, behaviours and the environment . We will make connections to Scripture and take action as God’s stewards.

Specialist Subjects

Italian

In Italian this term, we will be viewing educational YouTubes then identifying the sequential order of the days, months and seasons.

Physical Education

In Physical Education this term, we will be performing various activities requiring fundamental motor skills, such as dribbling, to stay active and healthy while at home.

Visual Arts

In Visual Arts this term, we will be focusing on developing Drawing skills. We will be experimenting with the use of line, shape, colour, texture and pattern in our artwork using a variety of easy to access art materials.



Literacy

Reading

In Literacy, we will be reading a variety of non-fiction texts to identify facts and information about various countries and cultures. We will also read aloud a variety of poems identifying the theme, structure, language, rhyme and rhythm..

Writing

In Writing, we will be learning how to compose concept maps about the countries of our heritage. We will focus on identifying continents, countries, population, location and a variety of different facts. We will learn how to paraphrase non-fiction information and use a dictionary to spell unfamiliar words.

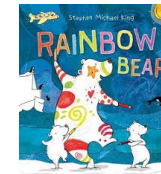
Another focus will be using various spelling strategies to assist in spelling unfamiliar words, for example using digraphs, trigraphs, and syllables.

Speaking and Listening

For Speaking and Listening, we will be exploring cultural phrases including greetings, and common expressions.

Library / Author Study

During Term 3, we will be reading a variety of Stephen Michael King’s fiction books and identifying the structures of a narrative.



Mathematics

Number & Algebra

In Maths, we will represent multiplication by grouping into sets, such as repeated addition, groups and arrays and we will be representing and solving simple division problems by grouping into equal sets.

Measurement & Geometry

We will be interpreting simple maps of familiar locations and identifying the relative position of key features.

In Measurement, we will be comparing and ordering the lengths of shapes using informal units.

Statistics & Probability

In Probability, we will identify and describe the outcomes of familiar events and activities involving chance using everyday language.



Social and Emotional Learning

This term, we will be focusing on using the catastrophe scale to rate problems. Throughout the term, we will discuss different problem scenarios and rate them on the catastrophe scale keeping the problem in perspective by justifying our choice of rating.

We will also use the catastrophe scale to rate:

- How is it going?
- How are you feeling?
- How big is the problem?

We will focus on using strategies to become resilient learners.



Inquiry

Our topic question for Inquiry this Term is, 'Who Are We?' We will be learning about the different cultures, which influence our community. We will identify and explore the various cultures of our peers, and identify their similarities and differences.
