# **Religious Education**

In Religious Education this term, we will be focusing on prayer and why it is an important aspect of our faith.

We will prepare the students for their First Reconciliation, with a focus on making appropriate choices and asking for forgiveness when we 'miss the mark'.

We will also be learning about Lent as a time of prayer, fasting and acts of kindness.

## Visual Arts

In Visual Arts this term, we will explore the difference between threads and textiles. We will also practise our skills in areas such as weaving, finger knitting, plaiting, cutting and sewing.





#### Italian

In Italian this term, we will be learning the difference between formal and informal greetings. We will also be translating simple sentences about their daily life from Italian to English and English to Italian.


# **Physical Education**

In Writing, we will be learning about writing information reports. We will focus on the difference between facts and opinions, topic-specific vocabulary, sub headings, writing in paragraphs, labelling diagrams and using topic sentences.

For Speaking and Listening, we will be Learning how to communicate and receive effective and purposeful feedback through performing a variety of scenarios and presentations. We will also be adapting and presenting information to different age groups.

#### Social and Emotional Learning

This term we are focusing on how we can be bucket fillers and we are learning to make new friendships as we get to know our new classmates.

We are learning how we can respect ourselves, respect others and respect the environment.



## **Mathematics**

During the term we will be focusing on data and place value.

The children will also be completing mental Maths tasks.



Learning our times tables "off-by-heart" will be a mathematics focus for the entire year.

Our topic for Inquiry this term is about having a healthy mind, body and soul. We will be identifying how we learn best and learning to respect and take care of ourselves and others.
