

Religious Education

In Religious Education, we will be exploring transformation through Lent and becoming the best individual we can be, like Jesus. We will continue to develop our Catholic identity by becoming an active participant in the celebration of the Eucharist.

Specialist Subjects

Visual Arts

In Visual Arts this term, we will focus on the properties and use of Threads and Textiles. We will learn to manipulate a variety of threads and fabric using our cutting, weaving, threading, plaiting, sewing and felting skills.



Italian

In Italian this term, we will be investigating the language required to share facts about yourself. e.g. What is your name? How old are you? What grade are you in?



Physical Education

In Physical Education this term, we will be focusing on the skills needed to attack and defend when playing invasion games. We will be using strategies and tactics in a variety of games, in a range of environments.



Literacy

For our author study, we will be exploring Paul Jennings, author and writer of many children's books and Australian Classic "Round the Twist". We will be unpacking a variety of his texts. We will investigate how authors hook the reader using a variety of techniques, and will apply these skills to their own creative writing.



We will be listening, sharing and asking questions to develop understanding. We will practise adjusting our speaking to suit the intended audience and the purpose of the interaction.



Mathematics

During the term, we will be posing questions, collecting data and creating a variety of data representations. We will practise becoming skilled data interpreters.

We will further develop our knowledge and understanding of place value, including decimals.

Inquiry

In Inquiry, students will be exploring leadership and identity. We will be participating in a Leadership Day developing skills in resilience, teamwork and collaboration.

Digital Technology and Design

This term in Digital Technology and Design the children will be discussing why we have rules and why abiding by the rules helps us to become positive digital citizens. The children will learn how to use an Apple Mac and how we can be cybersafe online.

Social and Emotional Learning

This term we are focusing on building positive relationships with our peers, buddies and teachers. We will be focusing on the qualities we need to have to be a great leader of Emmaus. We will learn what we need to do to ensure our Foundation buddies have a smooth transition to Primary School.
