During the school holidays we upgraded the school WiFi at a cost of about \$60 000. This upgrade is to ensure the effective running and reliability of our internet connections. We also had painters in to paint the poles in the piazza, decluttered and freshened up our Year 2 - 4 buildings and the fence where the car drove through was finally fixed. We are now waiting for our Masterplan to be completed by our architects, ROAM, so we can plan some further works in the school. We look forward to sharing these with you.



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Connection Time

At this time of the year we spend time getting to know each other and getting to know the children's new learning environment. It is very important to build relationships before we start teaching rigorously. The children have been involved in many 'connection' opportunities over the last week.

Last Thursday we had an open classroom afternoon. This was a wonderful chance for parents to visit their child's classroom to connect with classroom teachers. Many families took this opportunity and we enjoyed a sausage sizzle together. Thank you to all staff and parents who made this possible. Teachers are available in the afternoons after the bell for a chat. You can also email teachers. Seesaw will soon be operational as a means of communication.

Discovery Days

This week we began our Discovery Days. The students were divided into four groups based on friendship choices. They explored Visual Arts, Physical Education, STEM, and Performing Arts or Outdoor Discovery. Our specialist teachers work very hard to provide our students with wonderful learning experiences. While the children participate in their Discovery Day the teachers are involved in planning and preparation for the following week. All children are required to wear their sports uniform on their Discovery Day.

Carpark

Thank you for your patience with the car park. As always, the beginning of the year is very busy in the carpark. We are doing all we can to keep the cars moving with staff rostered on to support parents. Please be kind to one another and keep being patient as we work through these busy times. It is also a good idea to give yourself extra time in the morning so children can be at school on time. Every minute of the school day is important and to have children ready to learn in the morning supports them. Don't forget you can use the Pecks Road gate and the church gate to drop your children off and pick them up.

COVID Updates

This is my first year at Emmaus without the threat of COVID-19. We need to remember it is still around and we need to continue to implement important practices to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmissions. We will continue to ensure our air purifiers are used, external ventilation is maximised, good personal hygiene is encouraged, and face masks are made available for staff, students and visitors who wish to wear them. We are also recommended for students and staff to use a rapid antigen test (RAT) if they have symptoms or are in close contact with someone who has COVID-19. If your child is unwell, please keep them home from school.
