I, ______ (Emmaus student) believe that each student should feel happy, safe and have a sense of belonging in their learning environment.

I have certain rights that make sure I am safe and able to learn.

Like at all schools, I need to follow the rules and code of conduct.

This Code of Conduct is consistent with the Child Safety Standards. The code of conduct is based on rights, rules and responsibilities along with the following beliefs:

- That all students have the right to be safe.
- That all students have the right to be treated with respect.
- That all students have the right to work and play without interference.
- That all students should be encouraged to be polite, courteous and well-mannered.

Emmaus has six basic school rules and expectations:

- 5. Move safely
- 6. Treat all property with care

Our school runs smoothly and safely because we:

Before school:

Recess and Lunch Time:

- Remain seated while eating and drinking on the asphalts areas.

- Teasing, name-calling and offensive language.
- Leaving the school unattended and / or without permission.
