The exception is for funerals, with ten 'mourners' permitted. There will be no other activity in our churches over that time. See attachment for information for accessing Mass on TV and online."

Greetings, everyone!

As I start to prepare this letter it looks like the best of spring weather out there. (it's Wednesday: what will tomorrow bring? Through the week, several days have shown that spring hasn't arrived properly yet - and we're a week into October! I recall, however, that for many years it was always difficult to get the cricket season under way because of rain in October.)

A major happening for the Catholic Church in Australia formally assembled this week: the Plenary Council. You may recall that we participated in its earliest stages by writing responses to the question 'what do you think God is asking of the Church in Australia?' Our responses were forwarded to the central organising group. The responses from across Australia have been the substance that has shaped up the agenda for the Council. An attachment with this Letter outlines the six areas of the Council's agenda: Conversion, Prayer, Formation, Structures, Governance, Institutions. Another attachment indicates the process of the Council: *Getting ready for the Plenary Council: A quick refresher*.

We wait to hear ... and we pray. The 'Plenary Council Prayer' is at the end of this Letter.

This weekend is the 70th Anniversary of the group 'Al-Anon'. Al-Anon's purpose is to help families and friends of alcoholics or someone abusing alcohol to recover from the effects of living with someone whose drinking is a problem.

Similarly, Alateen is their recovery program for young people. Alateen groups are sponsored by Al-Anon members. Alateen provides support for teenagers affected by the problem drinking of a parent or other family member. The program of recovery is adapted from Alcoholics Anonymous and is based on the Twelve Steps, the Twelve Traditions, and the Twelve Concepts of Service. The only requirement for membership is that there be a problem of alcoholism in a relative or friend. Al-Anon/Alateen is not affiliated with any other organisation or outside entity. There are two key ways to find support for those who feel that they have a problem with a family member, work colleague or friend's drinking. Anyone interested can go to their national website: www.al-anon.org.au and/or call the Helpline: 1300 252 666 for confidential enquiries.

That brings to mind the well-known 'Serenity Prayer'. It is commonly quoted as:

God, grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change, courage to change the things I can, and wisdom to know the difference.

The writer of the prayer (Reinhold Niebuhr, 1892–1971) originally asked for courage first, and specifically for changing things that *must* be changed, not things that simply *can* be changed: Father, give us courage to change what must be altered, serenity to accept what cannot be helped, and the insight to know the one from the other.

The prayer spread rapidly, and was adopted and popularised by Alcoholics Anonymous and other twelve-step programs.

An attachment with this letter reflects on the prayer, saying that 'the scope and power of this prayer is clearly suited for all of us'.

That would have got the rich man's attention: the suggestion that he was missing something. The question from Jesus is: What do you have to do to expand your heart: to become big hearted enough to allow my heartbeat to become your heartbeat?'

'Lord, there is something you want me to do to enlarge my heart. There is something I must give up to enable this to happen. Lord, give me courage and trust. Lord, look steadily at me and love me, and help me to become as you want me to be.'

There's something of the Serenity Prayer in that, isn't there?

Let us pray for fruitful outcomes from the Plenary Council:

Come, Holy Spirit of Pentecost. Come, Holy Spirit of the great South Land. O God, bless and unite all your people in Australia and guide us on the pilgrim way of the Plenary Council.

Give us the grace to see your face in one another and to recognise Jesus, our companion on the road.

Give us the courage to tell our stories and to speak boldly of your truth. Give us ears to listen humbly to each other and a discerning heart to hear what you are saying.

Lead your Church into a hope-filled future, that we may live the joy of the Gospel. Through Jesus Christ our Lord, bread for the journey from age to age.

Amen.

This weekend, the Catholic Church in Australia marks Safeguarding Sunday.

The Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne and Sacred Heart/Emmaus Parish are committed to the care, wellbeing and protection of children, young people and people at risk in our community. Safeguarding and the dignity of every person is the responsibility of every adult.

A significant impact of COVID lockdowns for the Sacred Heart/Emmaus Parish has been that we have had to limit severely all our Ministry activity.

When restrictions begin to ease we will be in a position to reassemble our various ministry groups. That will be the opportunity to re-engage with our community in those well-established 'tried and true' ways, to re-form our groups and invite new participation, and to offer 'formation for ministry' as a refresher or an introduction.

If you do not have a WWCC, the procedures for acquiring one are on a following page. When a Card is sent to you, forward a copy to the Parish Office.
