Term 4, 2020 Year 1

Religious Education

Our big idea for this term is "How Do We Share The TRUE Meaning of Christmas?" We will be focusing on what Christmas means to us and the importance of this time. Students will learn about the Nativity story and the important roles of the Holy family. Students will make connections to the birth of Jesus.

Specialist Subjects

Italian

In Italian this term, we will be reading a sentence in Italian about our favourite day, month and season. We will listen to a famous Christmas story `La Befana'.

Physical Education

In Physical Education this term, we will be working cooperatively and demonstrating fair play, when participating in a variety of tagging and ball games.

Performing Arts

In Performing Arts this term, our focus will be on Drama. We will use body language and facial expressions to demonstrate different feelings. We will participate in improvisation and role play.

Social and Emotional Learning

This term, students will be focusing on reconnecting with their friends and establishing good friendships in readiness for Grade 2.



Literacy

Reading

This term, students will be identifying facts within non-fiction texts.

Writing

Students will learn to apply facts they have learnt from reading non-fiction texts and present this information in their own way.

Speaking and Listening

Students will have the opportunity to give a short presentation on their favourite animal.

To celebrate Book Week, students will be reading a variety of 'Book Week' books and complete various activities.



Mathematics

Number & Algebra

Students will be representing and solving division problems that involve sharing.

Measurement & Geometry

Students will be telling the time to the nearest half hour.

Students will describe the features of 2D shapes and 3D objects and investigate where they can find these shapes and objects in the environment.



Inquiry

This term, students will be learning about living things. They will be exploring the features of living things and identifying how they adapt to their habitat.
