Specialist Subjects

Visual Arts

In Reading, we are learning how to make predictions about what might happen in a story before and during reading. We are also talking about picture books and discussing what is entertaining or appealing and why.

Writing

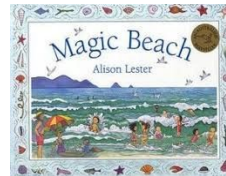
In Writing, we are learning about the features of a recount. We will be focusing on and including the 5W questions in our writing (who, what, when, where, why?).

Speaking and Listening

We are learning how to use 'whole body listening' to help us focus on the speaker. This means we look at the speaker with our eyes, listen with our ears, be active listeners and wait for our turn to speak.

Library / Author Study

We are reading a variety of Alison Lester books to learn about her style of writing.



Social and Emotional Learning

Mathematics

In Mathematics we are learning how to read, write and represent two digit numbers.

We are collecting data and representing it on picture graphs and bar graphs. We are learning how to interpret the data on our graphs in sentences and express it in verbal and written forms.
