Last week our Year 4 students celebrated their First Reconciliation together with their families in our Church with Father Maurie, Father Tom and Father Peter. They were well prepared by their teachers, Jade, Debbie and Marian and our Religious Education Leader, Lorraine. We still have COVID limitations at our church. We are now able to have 170 people at mass in our Church, so the Reconciliations were a lovely celebration with the children's nearest and dearest supporting them and celebrating with them.

This weekend we will be celebrating our Year 5 First Communion. They will be held at 1.30pm and 3pm Saturday, 13th March and Sunday, 14th March at 1pm. Our Year 5 children and their families have waited a whole year for this very special celebration. I'm sure the Emmaus community will keep them in their prayers.

Our Year 6s volunteered their time on the night to tour our new parents around our school. The parents were very impressed by their ability to present themselves so confidently and talk so glowingly about their school. We were all very proud to hear such wonderful feedback. Our Year 6 leaders are nominating themselves for leadership positions at the moment. We wish them the best of luck.
