<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Religious Education</u></p> <p>In Religious Education we will be further developing our understanding of the Easter Story. We will look at the meaning of the Resurrection and what it means to us today. We will be following our journey in faith and the many paths that lead us to discovering Jesus.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p><u>Reading</u> In Reading, we will be learning about narratives and their structure. We will also be developing our understanding to answer literal comprehension questions by referring to texts.</p> <p><u>Writing</u> In Writing, we will be learning to correctly compose a narrative using the correct structure. We will be focusing on using adjectives and using synonyms to enhance our writing.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>Throughout the term, we will be focusing on using various mental strategies to help solve both addition and subtraction equations. We will also look at the connection between addition and subtraction, to assist us with solving these equations.</p> <p>Students will also be learning about Location. Students will look at grid maps and interpret positions, using grid references.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Specialist Subjects</u></p> <p><u>Italian</u> In Italian this term, we will be learning to locate main cities on an Italian map. We will be researching some of the main landmarks in the regions.</p> <p><u>Physical Education</u> In Physical Education this term, we will be focusing on the strategies of chasing, fleeing and dodging. We will be applying these concepts when playing unstructured games such as tag and structured games such as basketball and soccer.</p>	<p><u>Speaking and Listening</u> For Speaking and Listening, we will be performing plays as part of student narratives. We will express the important character motives within a narrative.</p> <p><u>Library / Author Study</u> The Author Study for this term is Bob Graham. We will be reading and completing activities based on his books.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Inquiry</u></p> <p>We will be exploring rules and laws and why they are important. It is important to understand how to be safe online and how we create a digital footprint.
