## Topic Overview for Families

<p><b><u>Religious Education</u></b></p> <p>In Religion, we will be exploring the concept “Care for Creation”. Through scripture and real world events, we will be deepening our knowledge and understanding and exploring how we can build faith in relationship with all of God’s creation.</p>	<p><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p> <p>In Reading, we will be developing reading comprehension and enjoyment of reading novels through Literature Circles. In celebrating Book Week, the students will be examining a selection of books, comparing topics, themes and plots.</p> <p>In Writing, we will create historical narratives, experimenting with text structure and language features. We will also be learning to reread and edit our own and others’ work using agreed criteria explaining editing choices.</p> <p>For Speaking and Listening, we will be using interaction skills appropriate to group size and formality of interaction.</p>	<p><b><u>Mathematics</u></b></p> <p>In Maths this term, our focus will be multiplication and division. We will be exploring written and mental strategies to solve problems.</p> <p>Another focus will be on Measurement. Students will learn about reading timetables. We will be learning how to problem solve involving time and interpreting a variety of everyday timetables. We will also explore different aspects of time related to the Olympics.</p>
<p><b><u>Specialist Subjects</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Italian</u></b></p> <p>In Italian this term we will explore the cultural components of Italy’s geography, culture, people, food, music and sports. We will produce a passion project to share with others.</p> <p><b><u>Physical Education</u></b></p> <p>In Physical Education this term, we are continuing to monitor and assess our personal fitness levels in the areas of core strength, muscular power and heart stamina. We will partake in a research project, exploring the various fitness components to then create our own station as part of a class fitness circuit.</p> <p><b><u>Performing Arts</u></b></p> <p>In Performing Arts this term, we will learn about the elements of dance. We will view, choreograph and perform a variety of dance sequences. We will practise different dance styles from other countries and we will discuss expectations and safety rules in Performing Arts.</p>		<p><b><u>Digital Technology &amp; Design</u></b></p> <p>We will be learning to identify a problem, use a design process to come up with a solution with consideration of the environment.</p> <p>We will also be improving our digital communication by refining our iMovie skills.</p>
