<u>Religious Education</u>	<u>Literacy</u>	<u>Mathematics</u>
<p>In Religion, we will be exploring how we prepare and wait. We will be focusing on Advent being a waiting time for Christmas and the importance of this time. We will further our knowledge about the Nativity story and the important roles of the Holy family. We will make connections to Scripture and the birth of Jesus.</p>	<p><u>Reading</u> In reading this term, the focus will be on identifying the structure and features of an imaginative text. We will be exploring the author's purpose for writing the text.</p> <p><u>Writing</u> This term in writing we will be focusing on writing imaginative texts. We will also be learning how to add adjectives to our imaginative writing pieces.</p>	<p><u>Number & Algebra</u> We will be representing and solving problems that involve sharing. We are also learning how to recognise and describe fractions as equal parts of a whole or of a collection.</p>
<p><u>Specialist Subjects Italian</u> In Italian this term, we will be reading sentences about the days of the week -I giorni della settimana in Italian. We will also listen to a famous Italian Christmas fable/story, 'La Befana'. We will role play the story in Italian.</p> <p><u>Physical Education</u> In Physical Education this term, we will be developing and practising a range of motor skills such as jumping, running and hopping. We will be reconnecting with our peers while participating in physical activities and exercises that involve moving different parts of our bodies at the same time, focusing on coordination and balance. We will also be listening and observing how our body feels during and after exercise.</p> <p><u>Performing Arts</u> In Performing Arts this term, we will continue to explore dance styles from around the world. We will practise simple dance moves as a whole class and in small groups and we will focus on what makes a good dance performance.</p>	<p><u>Speaking and Listening</u> We will be describing characters, settings and events in imaginative texts. We will also be focusing on speaking clearly and listening to others during class discussions.</p>	<p><u>Measurement & Geometry</u> This term we will be measuring and comparing the capacity and mass of different objects.</p> <p><u>Statistics and Probability</u> We will be identifying outcomes of events that involve chance. We will be describing if they 'will happen', 'won't happen' or 'might happen'.</p>
