The report provided by our reviewer Emma Richardson stated that the school,

'has made progress against the priorities of the 2020 - 2023 School Improvement Plan (SIP), including to strengthen and embed knowledge and application of highly effective teaching practices, and to build a performance and development culture underpinned by collaboration, reflection and feedback. Emmaus Catholic Primary School has provided staff with a breadth of Professional Learning opportunities aligned to the priorities of the 2023 Annual Action Plan. The leadership and management of the school was endorsed by staff in the 2023 MACSSIS surveys, and the review found that positive cultural change had occurred. Collaborative and collegiate teams were operating with direct support from executive and instructional leaders, with the breadth and depth of professional learning creating an environment where teachers were striving to improve outcomes for all students. A commitment to enhancing partnerships across all areas of the school community should be maintained as a priority. Student wellbeing is a visible priority at Emmaus Catholic Primary School, with a sustained focus on building a restorative culture discussed by students, parents and staff. A positive impact of the whole school prioritisation of wellbeing was evident.'

We are thrilled that our dedicated team of teachers have been recognised for their hard work and commitment to all of the children, their families and their colleagues. We are sure our parent community will join with leadership in celebrating and congratulating each of them.

Over the next few weeks we will work with our Regional Leadership Consultant to develop our 2024 - 2027 Strategic Plan. We will be able to share this plan with our parent community early next year. It is a very exciting time at Emmaus.

#### 2024 Classes

We are currently finalising classes for next year. This year we can guarantee each child at Emmaus has been placed with at least one friend from their friendship list. We have endeavoured to accommodate teacher and parent recommendations, but as you can appreciate classes are socially complex and there are limitations to what we can put into place.
